

ABSTRACT

Objective :

To describe the frequency of different modes of delivery among mothers with past Lower Segment Caesarean Section (LSCS) and the incidence of the antepartum, intrapartum and postpartum maternal and foetal complications

Study design :

A descriptive study in a representative cohort of pregnant mothers with past LSCS.

Method :

259 expectant mothers were recruited for the study at 32 weeks or more in their current pregnancy, during the period, September 2002 to February 2003. The mothers with more than one previous LSCS and who had recurrent indications were not included in the sample.
