Library Committee

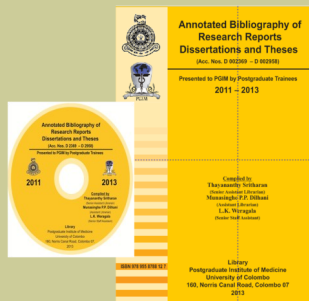

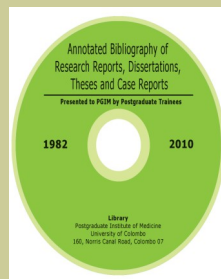
