- 1.2. List advantages and disadvantages in using a Clinical Decision Support System in clinical practice. (30 marks)

When data is captured in the field by field health staff (Example: Public Health Midwives) using mobile devices, it is important to ensure the quality of data by improving compliance in data entry.
