 - 1.2. Describe the fluid management and the management of **one** other problem mentioned above.
- 2. List the equipment you could use to monitor the state of the cardiovascular system in a patient undergoing a prolonged major surgery.
 - Briefly indicate the usefulness and limitations of the equipment you mentioned.
- 3. List the indications for general anaesthesia for a caesarean section. Describe your technique.
- 4. A patient complains of excruciating pain along the arm while administering thiopentone sodium.
 - 4.1. What is your probable diagnosis?
 - 4.2. List the other factors to support your diagnosis.
 - 4.3. How would you minimize this?
 - 4.4. Describe how you would manage this patient.

5. A 30 old man, who has fallen from a tree, is brought to the accident service. He is restless, agitated and is unable to move the lower limbs. His respiratory rate is 16/min, pulse rate 120/min with a blood pressure of 80/40mm Hg.

Outline your assessment and initial management of this patient.

- 6. A 45 year old lady with Type 1 diabetes mellitus controlled with insulin requires total abdominal hystetectomy. Describe your anaesthetic management.
- 7. A 24 year old ASA/1 patient is awaiting surgical extraction of an impacted. wisdom tooth.

Describe your anaesthetic management.

 - 8.1. Propofol
 - 8.2. Magnesium Sulphate (MgSO₂)
 - 8.3. Phenylephrine
