  - 1.2. As the medical officer in charge of the hospital emergency room, outline the initial steps of assessment of a patient with multiple injuries. (30 marks)
  - 1.3. List five (05) medico-legal issues that will arise in this situation. (10 marks)
  - 1.4. Outline how you would handle three (03) of the above mentioned medico-legal issues. (30 marks)
- 2. Over 300 villagers are displaced after a landslide and housed in a public place. As the Medical Officer of Health of the area, you are instructed by the Regional Director of Health Services to visit the place one-week after the landslide.
  - 2.1. List ten (10) priority health and social issues you would expect at the time of your visit. (20 marks)
  - 2.2. Describe briefly how you would manage three (03) of the above issues. (30 marks)
  - 2.3. List five (05) non-health organizations that can be involved in managing the issues mentioned in 2.1 above. (20 marks)
  - 2.4. Describe the steps you would take to ensure psychosocial wellbeing of the population. (30 marks)

- 3. Hospitals can get damaged during natural disasters like Tsunami, landslides and floods.
  - 3.1. Describe the aspects that should be given consideration when planning a new hospital building to make it disaster resilient.
