Three years later she developed metastasis in lungs and bone. Despite extensive chemotherapy the disease progressed.

Her daughters are worried their mother is finding it difficult to sleep and has to be seated bending forward all night as she finds it difficult to breathe.

Her oncologist decided there is no benefit from further chemotherapy for her.

She still has hopes to live and arrange the marriage of her two daughters.
