 - 1.3. Discuss the options available for definitive surgical management.
- 2. A diagnosis of Slipped Upper Femoral Epiphysis was made in a 12 year old boy.
 - 2.1. What clinical and radiological features that would have led to this diagnosis?
 - 2.2. Discuss the surgical management of this patient.
 - 2.3. List the possible complications of this condition and describe how you would avoid them.
