Use the formula  $NPV = C_i / (1+r)^i$

$C_i$  is the cash flow at period  $i$   
 $i$  is the period in years  
 $r$  is the cost of capital

$$IRR = X+Y (p/q)$$

$X$  discount rate which gives a positive NPV  
 $Y$  Difference between the discount rates  
 (in this sum it is  $15\% - 12\% = 3\%$ )  
 $p$  value of the positive NPV  
 $q$  range of the NPV values
