

Summary

Mrs.D, a 71 year old healthy lady was found unconscious at her home, recovered after two days with right side face-arm-leg weakness, left side pain and touch sensation impairment and vision impairment. Her CT and MRI/MRA scans showed left side thalamic intra-cerebral haemorrhage without vascular abnormality. Hyponatremia, urinary tract infection and constipation further complicated her condition and then resolved later. Her functional independence lost with the occurrence of intra-cerebral haemorrhage. She received care of a multi-disciplinary team, inclusive of physiotherapy and occupational therapy improving her functional status. Furthermore, she needs to be provided with nutritional care, home-environment modifications, psychological and emotional support.
