

Summary

Mr.W, a 79 year old patient presented with progressive memory impairment and a history of falls. One year ago, he had undergone prostatectomy and bilateral orchidectomy due to a prostatic carcinoma. His cognitive assessment revealed that he has severe dementia associated with neuropsychiatric symptoms. He has a significant risk for falls which necessitates optimization of his medical conditions, behavioural and environmental modifications. Functional dependency, financial difficulties, dementia-unfriendly home environment and burden on carer were challenges in management of this patient, which were addressed by multi-disciplinary team approach.
