

Summary

Mrs.K, an 83 year old patient diagnosed with hypertension and left side stroke with minimal disability was presented following an accidental fall. She had sustained left side intra-capsular, neck of femur fracture and had undergone Austin-Moore hemiarthroplasty. Her functional capacity reduced due to the fracture. Osteoporosis, uncontrolled hypertension, mixed deficiency anaemia, impaired renal functions and polypharmacy were major medical problems in the management of this patient. Gaining functional independence, environmental modifications, psychological and emotional support improved her quality of life.
