Summary

An 81 years old lady, known patient with hypertension and ventricular ectopics, and poor compliance to treatment, presented to accident service, NHSL, with altered level of consciousness after being found by her husband. She was then diagnosed to have a fracture of right femur. Surgical management was planned but she was found to have anaemia, poor cardiac function and developed acute kidney injury on chronic kidney disease. A conservative approach was taken after treatment of acute medical conditions as she was unfit for surgical intervention.
