

Summary

MS P, a 69-year-old unmarried patient with a history of hypertension presented with a history of fall and pain in the right hip following low impact injury. Examination and investigations revealed she has a right side intra capsular neck of femur fracture and she has undergone Austin Moore hemiarthroplasty and went home following 2nd postoperative day after starting low weight bearing gait training and physiotherapy. She achieved early mobilization and independence due to good postoperative care and follow up and physiotherapy.
