

**Summary:**

a 61-year-old known patient with alcohol induced dementia and hypertension presented with aggressive behavior and suspicious behavior towards wife and admitted at NIMH geriatric ward and his mini mental state examination is improved from 20/30 to 24/30 during hospital admission. His auditory hallucinations and psychotic symptoms were reduced after pharmacological and behavioral therapy during hospital stay and follow-up visits and diagnosed as alcohol induced dementia and late onset psychosis.
