

## **Summary**

66-year-old Mrs. T newly diagnosed patient with hypertension presented with gradual onset of right-side arm and leg weakness for 1-day duration. No sensory impairment. Investigations revealed a multiple lacunar infarct in non-contrast CT brain. On Admission, Barthel index is 50 out of 100 and she was managed with Physiotherapy and occupational therapy and antihypertensive medications to control her blood pressure. Her barthel index improved up to 80 out 100 during her stay in the ward and could walk independently when she was about to discharge from the hospital
