

Summary

a 67-year-old male hypertensive patient develops lower urinary tract symptoms 2 years back and recurrent Urinary tract infection. LUTS progress with time with progressively increased levels of PSA and abnormal USS prostate. Then he underwent USS guided prostate biopsy and diagnosed to have a prostate cancer and uneventful laparoscopic radical prostatectomy done. Post-operative histology report came as adenocarcinoma of the prostate. No perianal or vascular invasion or pelvic lymph node spread was present. He was referred to Apeksha Hospital Maharagama and Radiotherapy started. He follows urology clinic and clinic at maharagama cancer hospital regularly at the moment.
