

Summary

Sixty seven year old mother of six children presenting with gradually progressive forgetfulness for a period of two years. She has other associated psychotic features, including delusion of infidelity and persecutory delusions which precede the onset of cognitive impairment. Evidence of both frontal lobe and dominant parietal lobe functional impairment were noted on cognitive assessment.

Multiple problems were identified on holistic assessment, some of which pertaining to the disease such as memory impairment, hostile behaviour, social isolation and caregiver burden.

Environmental hazards and risk of fall were issues in comprehensive geriatric assessment.
