

Summary

A Sixty seven year old diagnosed lady with seronegative rheumatoid arthritis with associated multiple comorbidities for a period in excess of ten years presented with right wrist joint pain associated with small joint swelling and stiffness. She had evidence of active synovitis which was managed as an acute flare of rheumatoid arthritis.

Chronic disease process result in functional impairment with poor ability to perform activities of daily living, frailty and some environmental hazards were identified on further assessment.
