

Summary

A seventy seven year old with a history of multiple co-morbidities including left ischaemic stroke, diabetic mellitus, hypertension and is bed ridden following right above knee amputation for peripheral vascular disease, present with generalized oedema and acute onset shortness of breath. Acute episode was managed as acute on chronic renal impairment.

Moderate to severe depression, caregiver burden, bed ridden patient , wheel chair mobilization, multiple environmental challenges were important problems identified in comprehensive geriatric assessment.
