

### **Summary**

Mrs. D, a 60-year-old housewife from Kottawa, is a diagnosed patient with poorly controlled type 2 diabetes mellitus and hypertension was referred to Rheumatology and Rehabilitation hospital (RRH), for rehabilitation following a left side cerebellar infarction complicated with hemorrhagic transformation and hydrocephalous.

On examination she had left side face, arm, and leg weakness with MRC-0/0 (proximal muscle / distal muscle) of left upper limb and MRC grade 2/1 of left lower limb. Barthel index at the time of presentation is zero.

Prolong ICU stay following the stroke; persistent disability even after one year of post stroke rehabilitation, inadequate awareness regarding post stroke rehabilitation and lack of community care were identified as major contributors for the poor prognosis of the patient.
