Summary

Thirty year old unmarried hairstylist from Rajagiriya presented for voluntary sexual health screening. He was a bisexual male and his last sexual exposure was unprotected insertive anal and oral sex one day prior to the presentation with a non regular partner. He has had more than 100 male partners for life time and two female partners for life time. He consumes alcohol, cigarettes and cocaine. There was no significant findings in examination.

He was found to have a retroviral infection. Further he had a non reactive VDRL and a positive TPPA test and he was diagnosed with HIV and Syphilis co infection. CD4 count at base line was 599 cell/ul and viral load at base line was 130013copies per milliliter. Excluding opportunistic infections and coinfections was done. Psychiatry referral was arranged as he had a low mood and was started on Clonazepam on 22/11/2019 following diagnosis of adjustment disorder. He was treated for late latent syphilis with intramuscular benzathine penicillin 2.4 MU three doses. He was initiated on anti-retroviral therapy (tenofovir 300mg, emtricitabine 200mg and efavirenz 600mg) on 13/11/2019 and prophylaxis for tuberculosis after excluding the infection.
