

Summary

A 25 years old unmarried male sex worker with past history of latent syphilis was diagnosed as HIV positive on 19th of November 2019. He had signs of secondary syphilis and four-fold rising VDRL titre. He was given IM benzathine penicillin 2.4 MU one dose for secondary syphilis. His HIV viral load was 4813 cells/ mL and CD4 count 613 cells/mm³. Due to positive tuberculin skin test, he was diagnosed as having latent tuberculosis. Without starting INAH prophylaxis antiretroviral treatment was started due to grade 1 liver toxicity and grade 1 fatty liver. He was transferred to STD clinic Matara as requested by patient.
