## Summary

Thirty-four years old spa worker referred to STD clinic Kalubowila by the magistrate court Nugegoda to exclude sexually transmitted diseases and she had offensive mild yellowish vaginal discharge for one-week duration. She denied penetrative sexual exposures at the spa and she had unprotected vaginal sex with a regular male partner for two years duration. She had scanty whitish, offensive vaginal discharge and cervix was inflamed. Wet vaginal smear showed *Trichomonas vaginalis* parasites. Gram stained vaginal smear revealed positive clue cells and absence of lactobacilli. She was diagnosed as having trichomoniasis and bacterial vaginosis. She was treated with metronidazole 400 mg twice per day for one week. Other sexually transmitted diseases were excluded and her regular partner was screened and epi treated for *Trichomonas vaginalis* infection. Test of cure was done after seven days of treatment and it was negative. However, she defaulted clinic visit after this.
