

## Summary

A 35 year old unmarried assistant executive male presented with a purulent urethral discharge and dysuria for 2 days duration. During examination there was profuse, purulent urethral discharge. Intracellular gram negative diplococci were seen in urethral smear for gram stain. Cultures were negative for gonococci.

He was treated with single dose of cefixime 400 mg for gonococcal infection. He was also treated for possible chlamydial coinfection with oral doxycycline 100 mg twice a day for 7 days. Patient responded well for treatment.

He was tested for other STIs and no other diseases detected. Contact tracing and epidemiological treatment for partner/s could not be completed as patient had many previously unknown partners.

This patient was completely followed up till final serology.
