Summary

Mrs. PF a 65-year-old diagnosed patient with Diabetes Mellitus and Hypertension for 10 years presented with sudden onset left sided face, arm, leg (FAL) weakness and there was no history of LOC or seizures.

Physical examination revealed left sided hemiplegia with a upper motor neuron (UMN) type facial nerve palsy on the same side. Her Barthel's Index was 4/20 and Modified Ranking Scale was 4.

Non-contrast CT scan of the brain showed a right sided intra capsular infarction.

she received multidisciplinary care at rehabilitation hospital, Ragama and her Barthels Index and Modified Ranking Scale at discharge was 9/20 and 3.
