

Summary

77 -year-old lady, a housewife and mother four children, who's diagnosed to have DM not on proper follow up and had undergone Left side dynamic hip screw procedure for left side neck of femur (NOF) fracture 1 year back, presented to accident services department following a fall. She was complaining of severe pain over R/ hip joint and inability of walking. She was then diagnosed to have R/NOF fracture, and dynamic hip screw surgery was performed. Her frailty increased following the fall. Functional dependency, caregiver burden, environmental risk factors for falls, poor adherence to treatment for diabetes mellitus (DM) and communication issues were among major challenges identified.
