Summary

Mrs. B, 70 yr old lady from Piliyandala, a housewife and a mother of six children, diagnosed to have hypertension and diabetes but not on proper follow up, complains of poor urinary stream and intermittent urinary passage for more than 1-year duration, admitted for cystoscopy. On examination, she was found to have a uterovaginal prolapse with a small cystocoele. Social embarrassment due to urinary symptoms, fear of surgical complications were major issue identified prior surgical procedure(urethrotomy). Poor motivation to follow up due to her family and financial issues are the major problems identified postoperatively. Lack of multidimensional management and inadequacy of community care are major challenges identified in the management of Mrs. B.
