

Summary

A 67 year of old male a father of two who worked as tourist guide presented with lower urinary tract symptoms such as frequency, poor stream, urgency and dysuria for 2 and half years duration who also has a history of bladder calculus and undergone cystolithotripsy 2 years back found to have enlarged prostate gland on digital rectal examination. Ultra sound scan showed enlarged prostate gland. His PSA value was 4.8 ng/dl. He was on Tamsulosin and Finasteride for past two and half years. As the symptoms progressively worsened Trans urethral resection of the prostate was done.
