

## **Summary**

A 60 year old male who has had a right middle cerebral artery ischaemic stroke in August 2018 brought with gradual onset memory loss, aggressive behavior and wandering behavior since four months duration. He has been treated as vascular dementia with moderate impairment of activities of daily living. He has had depressive symptoms and suicidal thoughts. He has been treated with risperidone donepezil sertraline and clonazepam. He showed some improvement with the drugs

Social problems such as Risky behaviour and disinhibition also were identified. Care giver burden was most significant.
