Summary

This 65 year old diagnosed patient with sero positive rheumatoid arthritis (RA) presented to routine clinic follow up after defaulting treatment for one month with pain and swelling of small joints of hands and feet with no significant large joint involvement. On examination she was found to have evidence of active disease of small joints of both hands and feet.

She was restarted on disease modifying anti rheumatoid drugs (DMARDS) and further investigations were done to find any other cause for underlying anaemia.
