

Summary

Mr G.U is a 61 year old diagnosed patient with dementia for one year duration. This time he presented with behavioural changes like poor sleep, irritability, forgetfulness and suspiciousness towards his wife. Mini mental state examination revealed his cognitive impairment was in the mild dementia range. His non contrast computed tomography of the brain (NCCT brain) revealed he has generalized brain atrophy.

Other causes for this behaviour was excluded apart from dementia.

After admission he was also found to have a high fasting blood sugar value in the impaired glucose tolerance range.
