- 1.1. Describe the leading causes of bacterial meningitis and how they change across the lifespan. (30 marks)
- 1.2. Discuss the key parameters measured on cerebrospinal fluid and compare findings in pyogenic meningitis with meningitis by other microbial pathogens. (30 marks)
- 1.3. Discuss common features of the leading pathogens of pyogenic meningitis and key elements of the immunological response to these bacteria in humans. (40 marks)
- 2. Antimicrobial resistance is increasing, and many attempts have been made to contain it. Discuss the "One Health approach" on antimicrobial resistance.
