

Abstract

Lawrence syndrome is a very rare disorder of fat tissue that is due to the loss of fat from the different parts of the human body, happening from the birth. Cause is not known. Most acquired generalized lipodystrophy patients have had diabetes mellitus, high triglyceride level and accumulation of in the hepatocytes. We report a patient who is a 27year old lady who was presented with osmotic symptoms, generalized body wasting due to the loss of body fat and healed skin rashes all over the body. She was diagnosed to have an acquired generalized lipodystrophy associated with insulin resistant diabetes mellitus with positive ketone bodies in urine, isolated high triglycerid e level and hepatomegaly.
