Tuberculosis (TB) is one of the infective diseases known to cause health burden worldwide. Affecting one third of the world population with significant morbidity and mortality. Sri Lanka is one of the endemic countries for TB in Southeast Asia. Even though pulmonary infection is more common, significant number of patients present with extrapulmonary TB and disseminated TB as well. TB has a wide array of clinical presentation which was reported time to time by several Clinicians. Here we report a case where hypercalcemia was the only abnormal finding in a patient who was eventually diagnosed with TB lymphadenitis.
