

Abstract

Granulomatosis with polyangiitis(GPA) is a rare multisystem small vessel vasculitis where it is associated with ANCA,however, 10% of cases may be negative for ANCA. GPA has a broad spectrum of clinical presentation with constitutional symptoms as well as symptoms related to the renal, respiratory tract, skin, and nervous system involvement. Tissue biopsy with necrotizing granulomatous inflammation confirms the diagnosis of GPA. Here we report a case of middle-aged woman diagnosed with ANCA negative GPA.
