

## **Abstract**

Dengue virus infection is an arthropod born infection with high global prevalence. Spectrum of clinical syndromes and complications were recognized following dengue fever which starting from undifferentiated fever to dengue shock syndrome. Neurological complications following dengue fever can extend up to various sequelae including transverse myelitis. We reports a 20-year-old pregnant mother with recent diagnosis of dengue hemorrhagic fever (DHF) at her 28<sup>th</sup> week of period of amenorrhea (POA), presented with left sided severe buttock pain. Following extensive investigations we found left sided sacroiliitis as the cause for the buttock pain. She completely recovered with appropriate managements.
