Abstract

Leptospirosis is a common zoonotic disease of tropical and temperate region including Sri Lanka and worldwide which is caused by leptospira interrogans. It presents as an acute illness with fever and broad spectrum of clinical presentation and in severe cases it can leads to multi organ failure . This disease occurs where the infected rodents proliferate. The disease occurs as two phasic illness, leptospiremia phase and immune phase. There is various neurological manifestation have been reported during the immune phase of illness. Neuroleptospirosis, which is frequently manifested by aseptic meningitis, spinal extradural hematoma, myelopathy, intracerebral bleed, myeloradiculopathy, Guillain-Barré syndrome and neuropathies like mononeuritis, facial palsy

We present a case of a young man who presented with fever with liver impairment and acute right sided palatal palsy found to have leptospirosis infection.
