Abstract

Tuberculosis is an important disease worldwide and Tuberculosis(TB) spondylitis or Spinal Tuberculosis(Pott's disease) is an uncommon manifestation of extra pulmonary TB and common manifestation of musculoskeletal TB.It is a rare clinical condition but it associated with severe functional impairment and neurological sequale. The diagnosis of TB spondylitis may be delayed due to it's nonspecific clinical features. But early correct diagnosis and commencement of Anti TB treatment will prevent the progression and debilitation of the disease. Tuberculous spondylitis accounts for 1-5% of TB cases and represents about 50% of all bone and joint TB.rculous Spondylitis as a combination of clinical and radiological diagnosis.

Case Presentation

Our patient is a 57 year old male from Sri Lanka, who was a diagnosed patient with pulmonary Tuberculosis 20 years back with a history of successful treatment completion for 6 months. He was a chronic alcohol user and had a
