Abstract

Primary hyperparathyroidism is a condition where serum parathyroid hormone and serum Calcium both elevated than the normal range and it is caused by Parathyroid gland pathologies mainly like parathyroid adenoma. This endocrine disease is commonly caused by parathyroid adenoma. Clinical features are mainly due to hypercalcaemia. Scintigraphy and neck ultrasound are useful in diagnosis. Bilateral neck exploration and invasive surgical procedures of neck were used as treatment methods for removal of adenomas.
