Abstract

Pulmonary Langerhans cell Histiocytosis (PLCH) is a rare cystic interstitial lung disease which has a strong association with smoking¹. It is a disease that primarily affect young smoking adults. The presentation of PLCH vary where the individuals may present with spontaneous pneumothorax to chronic cough with marked constitutional symptoms². Nevertheless hemoptysis is an uncommon presentation. Here I report a case of pulmonary Langerhans cell histiocytosis in a chronic smoker presented with massive hemoptysis.
