

**Abstract:**

Autoimmune hepatitis (AIH) is a chronic inflammatory disease of liver which classically affects young females. It is characterized by autoantibodies, elevated gammaglobulins and interface hepatitis on histology. The clinical presentation of AIH can be asymptomatic, acute or fulminant liver failure. Here, we present a 45 year old male who presented with jaundice turned out to be having AIH and subsequent fulminant liver failure.
