

ABSTRACT

Artery of Percheron occlusion causes bilateral para-median thalamic infarction. Which is rare cause of ischemic stroke presents with altered conscious level, hyper-somnolence and eye movement disorder. Here, we report a case of 54 year old female patient with background history of type 2 diabetic mellitus and dyslipidemia presented with reduced level of consciousness, left side ptosis, anisocoria and right side hemiplegia. Early diagnosis is challenging in the acute setting but later, MRI brain bilateral thalamic infarct possibly due to occlusion of artery of pecheron.
