

## **ABSTRACT**

Sarcoidosis is a chronic multisystem inflammatory disease, characteristic by non-caseating granuloma formation in various organs. There is less frequency of involvement of sinus in sarcoidosis. A 40-year-old male presented with recurrent history of chronic sinusitis which was less responded to initial oral antibiotic therapy. He had bilateral cervical and axillary lymphadenopathy as well as mediastinal lymphadenopathy. Biopsy of lymph node shown non-caseating granuloma suggestive of sarcoidosis. His angiotensin converting enzyme (ACE) level was also elevated. Further investigation revealed no other systemic involvement. His symptoms were subsided by corticoid inhalational therapy.
