Abstract

Cerebral Venous Sinus Thrombosis is a condition with variable clinical signs and symptoms which make it a challenging condition to diagnose. Even this can affect all the age groups, this predominantly affect young population. We report a 27-year-old female who presented with acute onset headache which leads to the diagnosis of Cerebral Venous Sinus Thrombosis (CVST) with Oral Contraceptive pills as the predisposing factor. Only limited number of adult cases were reported in Sri Lanka.
