Abstract

Sarcoidosis is a rare multisystem inflammatory disease with an unknown etiology, and it is characterized by the presence of microgranuloma in affected tissues. It has varying clinical manifestations related to affected organ systems. Being an uncommon disease entity, presence of diverse clinical manifestations and complex diagnostic workup, often result in delaying or missing diagnosis of the condition giving rise to adverse outcomes.

In this case report, we diagnosed pulmonary sarcoidosis in a male patient who was investigated for a prolonged fever accompanying marked constitutional symptoms without having an apparent focus of infection or inflammation. Hopefully, this report will enhance awareness of this uncommon disease among medical teams as early diagnosis and proper management will result in excellent outcomes.
