

**A rare case report on Refeeding syndrome of an inward female patient following treatment for thyrotoxic crisis.**

**ABSTRACT –**

Refeeding syndrome is a complex and potentially life threatening clinical syndrome in the process of nutritional replenishment in a starved patient. Rapid restoration of nutrients is one of the major risk factors and early suspicion and diagnosis will enhance the survival rate (1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 13,16). Here we present an inward patient who developed refeeding syndrome following treatment for thyrotoxic crisis. Early recognition and intervention of refeeding syndrome ensured an uncomplicated recovery for this patient.
