Abstract

Introduction

Melioidosis is a serious and life threatening systemic infection when left untreated . We report a case of a patient presenting with chronic joint infection, splenic abscesses and cerebral venous sinus thrombosis. He was initially treated as Pseudomonas infection. Blood culture became positive for *Burkholderia pseudomallei*. His clinical status improved following long term antibiotic therapy.

Conclusion

Melioidosis can be easily mistaken for Pseudomonas infection. This can affect the optimal management and results in significant morbidity. It is important to specifically look for the organism when clinically indicated.
