Abstract

Staphylococci and streptococci cause 80% of infectious endocarditis, and staphylococci are the most common pathogen causing infective endocarditis currently [2]. Most serious and most frequent extra-cardic manifestation of infective endocarditis is cerebral complications such as ischemic infraction [2]. Here we report a case of 83 year old gentleman presented with right side body weakness and fever found to have large left sided vegetation with septic embolism with blood culture evidence of staphylococcus aureus.
